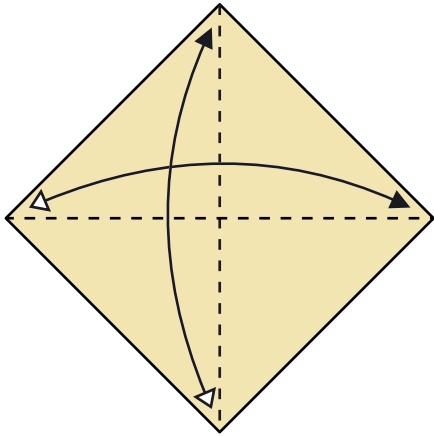
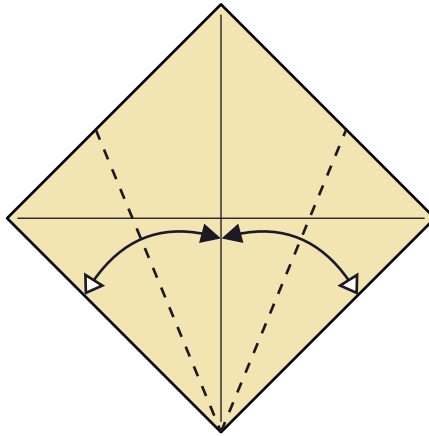


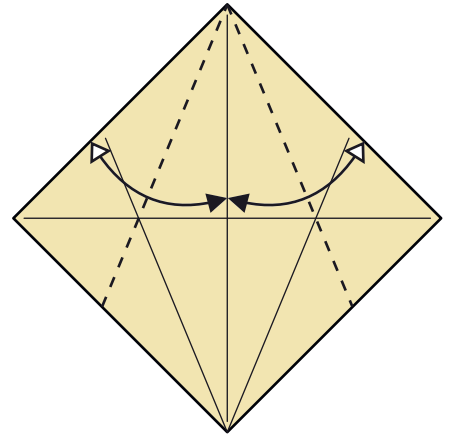
Whale (traditional)



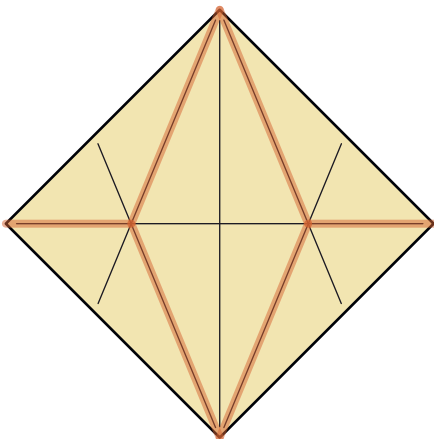
1. Fold and unfold the diagonals.



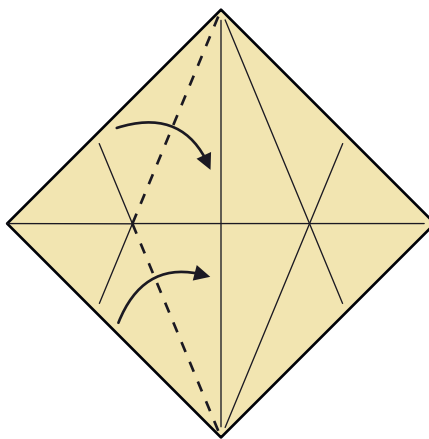
2. Fold the lower edges to the vertical crease, then unfold.



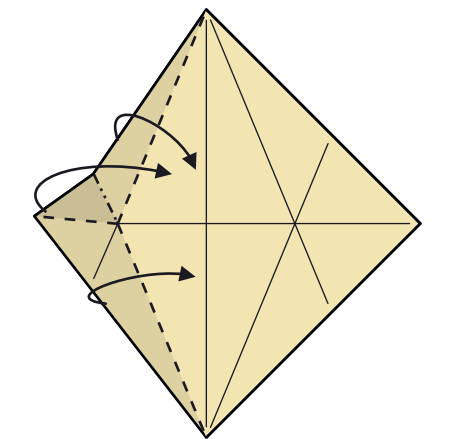
3. Fold the upper edges to the vertical crease, then unfold.



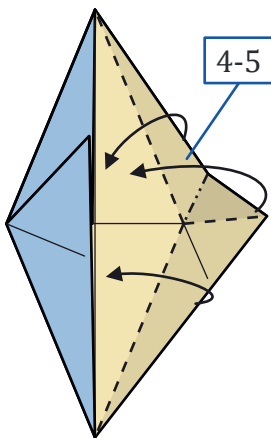
Observe the fish base highlighted here.



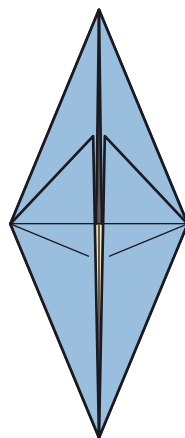
4. Start refolding the top and bottom creases on the left half of the square, as shown.



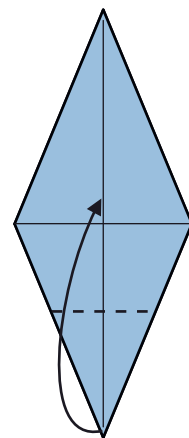
5. Pinch the horizontal crease on the left and flatten the corner upwards.



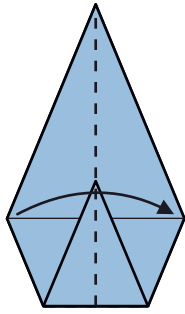
6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 on the right.



7. Turn the paper over.



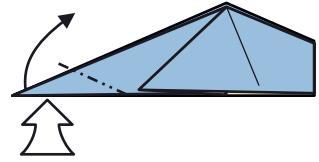
8. Fold the bottom corner up a little past halfway.



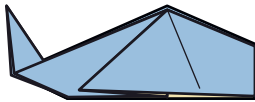
8. Fold the left half onto the right half.



9. Rotate the paper anticlockwise $\frac{1}{4}$ of a turn.

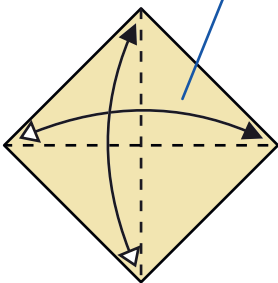


10. Reverse-fold the corner upwards to make a tail.

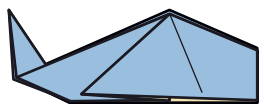


Penguin (Traditional)

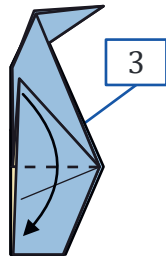
Whale: 1-10



1. Start with the steps 1 to 10 of the Whale (the whole model).



2. Rotate the paper $\frac{1}{4}$ of a turn clockwise.



3. Fold the flipper down (unless your penguin is very excited). Repeat behind.
